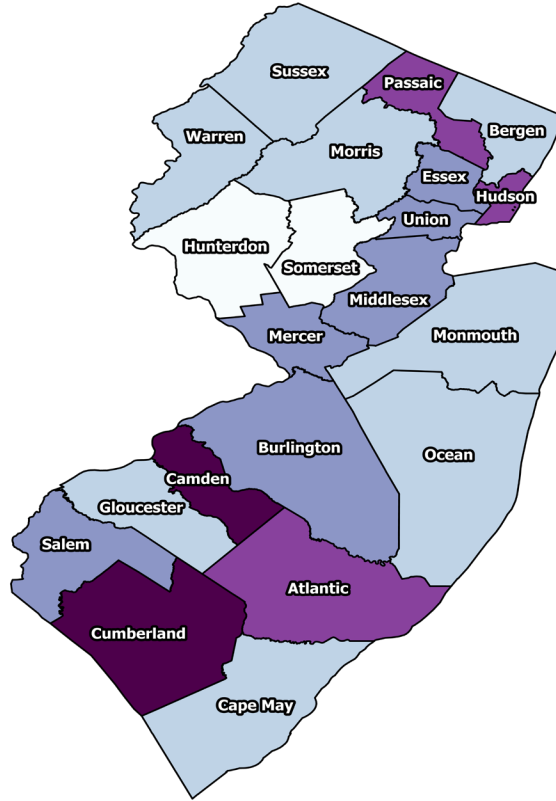
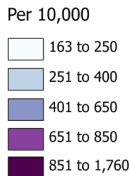


Puerto Rican Population
